Whenever possible, lyrics for at least the refrain will be either on the screen, in Nearby Chat, or a link will be provided so you can follow along if you wish. There is a bulletin for the service, if you want one, in the red binder near the door.

Taize worship is a contemplative type of worship developed by the ecumenical monastic community of Taize, France.

It incorporates repetitive prayers set to music, sometimes in different languages, along with moments of silent prayer, scripture, and other readings or prayers. The use of repetitive sung prayers allows us to to turn off our thinking mind and allow the music and prayer to sink into our hearts.

I encourage you, if you are some place where you feel safe doing so, to try singing along with the sung prayers once you get the rhythm.

The scriptures are the Daily Readings from the Revised Common Lectionary. Let us open our hearts to God.

When the child was older, he went out one day to his father among the reapers.

If you meet anyone, give no greeting, and if anyone greets you, do not answer; and lay my staff on the face of the child."

Then the mother of the child said, "As the Lord lives, and as you yourself live, I will not leave without you."

So he rose up and followed her.

Gehazi went on ahead and laid the staff on the face of the child, but there was no sound or sign of life.

He came back to meet him and told him,
