It's good to be real in Second Life! And as a UCC church, we'd like you to know that "No matter who you are, or where you are on life's journey, you are welcome here." Our service will be in voice and text. Music will be on the media viewer, so be sure that you have voice and media turned on. If you don't know how to do that, let someone know and we'll try to help. There will be a link in Nearby Chat so you can watch it in your browser if the viewer isn't working for you. Whenever possible, lyrics for at least the refrain will be either on the screen, in Nearby Chat, or a link will be provided so you can follow along if you wish. There is a bulletin for the service in the red binder near the door. Taize worship is a contemplative type of worship developed by the ecumenical monastic community of Taize, France. It incorporates repetitive prayers set to music, sometimes in different languages, along with moments of silent prayer, scripture, and other readings or prayers. The use of repetitive sung prayers allows us to to turn off our thinking mind and allow the music and prayer to sink into our hearts. I encourage you, if you are some place where you feel safe doing so, to try singing along with the sung prayers once you get the rhythm. Now, let us take a moment and in silence open our hearts to God. birds of the air, fish of the sea, and all sea creatures - coral and dolphin, seal and eel, whale and oyster. We do not sing in these days but we whisper with great joy -O God, how majestic is your name in all the earth! We pray all this, in the name of the one who taught us to pray together: Our Father who art in heaven hallowed be thy name thy kin-dom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil for Thine is the kin-dom and the power and the glory, forever. Amen.
